

LIMBS... All Dakota limbs have been designed to be stable , smooth to draw ,and have great speed . Its hard to find a bow that is smooth that has good speed or that's fast but stacks , which makes for a bow that's hard to shoot and is very unforgiving . The Dakota bow offers you the best of both worlds.

Wood choices for Limbs

Red Elm (flat grain),Red Elm (edge grain), Hard Rock Maple

Curly maple, Bird Eye Maple, Walnut, Purple Heart, Bubinga, Zebra, Osage, Bocote, Cocobola, Pau Ferro, Action Bamboo(Natural or Amber) Cane Bamboo (Natural)

Riser Deflex design – proven to be consistently more accurate and less critical to shoot. The shelf is shaped specifically to provide the least resistance and maximum clearance needed for clean arrow flight.

Wood choices for Riser

Cocobolo or Bocote

FIBERGLASS COLORS...

Clear , brown ,black, White

MICARTA TIPS... All Dakota bows have heavy duty micarta tips.

FAST FLIGHT STRINGS... All Dakota bows are designed to shoot a fast flight string .

TAKING PROPER CARE OF YOUR

BOW... Follow these simple rules to maintain your bows longevity.

1. Always use bow stringer , string or unstring your bow
2. Stringing between your legs , may warp or possibly crack your limbs.
3. Do not stand your bow in the corner or hang it on the wall by the limb tip, this could also cause your limbs to warp.
4. Do not leave your bow exposed to heat. (like leaving your bow in your car in the summertime) Heat will cause your bow to de-laminate.

Any of these abuses will void your warranty!

RECURVE... The custom Dakota recurve is a reflex,deflex design , designed by Rick himself , that makes for a smooth , fast shooting bow. The Dakota recurve is offered in three lengths 58", 60" and 62". Speed 50# @ 28", 200 fps. (Shot with fingers not a machine)

You won't find a smoother drawing bow that also has great speed. 62" recurve stacks 2 lbs. Per inch to 28 inches, 2.5lbs. pounds per inch from 29 to 30". The Custom Dakota recurve is the only wood bow to place in the top 5 in the world championships in the past 10 years, also the Dakota recurve has won 35 world championships in that time frame.

Longbow The custom Dakota longbow, like the Dakota recurve has a reflex, deflex design. I designed this new style longbow to create a better, more enjoyable bow to shoot, the heavier riser has less hand shock and has a grip that fits like a glove, which enables you to grip your bow the same way each time. This translates into a great shooting bow. The custom Dakota Longbow is offered to you in one model. There are three lengths to choice from 60",62",64" inches. Dakota Hunter Longbow (Speed 50# @ 28" is 190 fps.



All grips are shaped to fit your needs . Proper grip is critical to consistent shooting . Low, med , high wrist to best suit your shooting style . Thick or narrow grip. Smooth faced or finger grooves riser which fits like a glove.

All DAKOTA BOWS HAVE TAKE-DOWN CAPABILITY... Designed and built to put at ease the minds of those who are leery of purchasing a takedown bow for the first time or those who might have had a bad experience with take down bows . The Dakota bows have a limb bolt and a dowel pin made of steel which will keep your limb in place , always.
